

# **MR. SFORZA'S NOTES CHECK SCORING**

<b>Perfect Score</b>	<b>100 points</b>
<b>Deduction – Late Notes</b>	<b>-20 points</b>
<b>Deduction – Missing Notes</b>	<b>-12 points each</b>
<b>Deduction – Notes Not in a Binder</b>	<b>-10 points</b>

## **MR. SFORZA'S NOTES CHECK RULES**

1. Notes must be handwritten. Photocopies are not acceptable.
2. Submitting any notes that are not your own will result in a score of zero.
3. Notes must be in order when I come to your desk on Notes Check Day. If your notes are out of order, you will be required to submit them late.
4. If you are absent on Notes Check Day, you must show me your notes on the day you return to school, with a letter from home explaining your absence. Notes not submitted on the day you return will be considered late.
5. Rules for submitting notes late or improving a score of less than 80:
  - a. You may submit your notes only once during Notes Check Week for a maximum possible score of 80.
  - b. You must find me during lunch or after school. I will not check your notes in class and you cannot leave your notes with me to be checked.
  - c. To improve your score, you must re-submit all of your notes, not just the notes you were missing.
  - d. You must submit your notes in person. You may not leave your notes in my mailbox or under my door.
  - e. Friday of Notes Check Week is the final day to have your notes checked.
